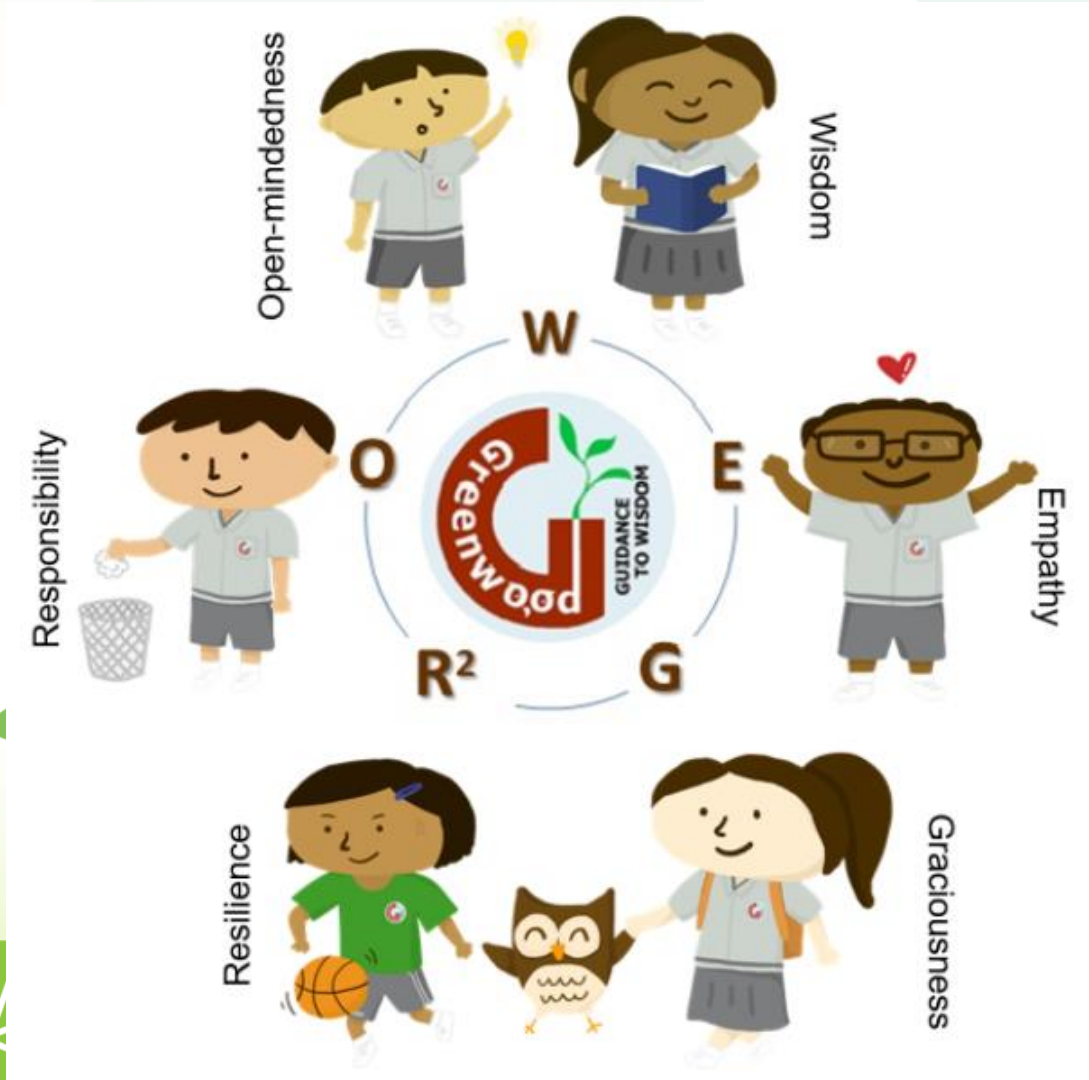

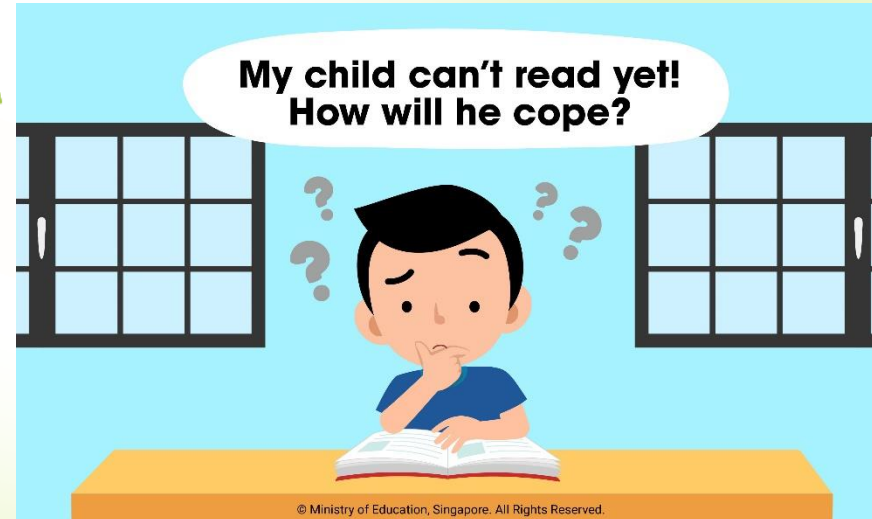

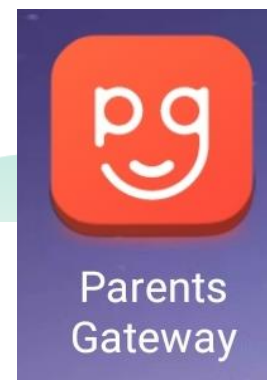

# PARENTS GATEWAY APP



Parents Gateway (PG) is a mobile app:

- Connects parents and schools on key administrative matters, allowing schools to send updates on programmes and activities to parents;
- For parents to perform administrative functions such as providing consent for their children to participate in school activities.

It aims to aggregate parent-teacher communications securely on a centralised digital platform. It is integrated with existing MOE records systems, so updates will be reflected in Parents Gateway in real-time.

# PARENTS GATEWAY APP

- Access to Parents Gateway is granted to parents and legal guardians of students studying in MOE schools in Singapore. You will need your SingPass to access Parents Gateway
- Parents Gateway is currently only available as a mobile application. Supported Operating System Versions: Android 5.0 or later & iOS 9.1 or later.
- For parents who see “No Access” after logging in, we are updating the information at our end. All parents/legal guardians will be able to access PG from 29 Nov 2021.



# STUDENT DETAILS FORM

- The Student Details Form Portal is an online portal that MOE HQ has developed to collect pupil data digitally. The portal can be accessed by Parent using Singpass account.
- A Parent who has successfully registered the child/ward for 2022 P1 and the child/ward is starting P1 in 2022 will be able to access the SDF portal using their Singpass account to submit pupil data.
- Details of the portal will be shared with parents via email and Parents Gateway on 29 Nov 2021

# GIRO APPLICATION

# STANDING ORDER FOR USE OF EDUSAVE ACCOUNT

- All Singapore Citizen students will have an Edusave account automatically opened for them and receive a yearly contribution. Parents can sign up for the Edusave standing order to use your child's Edusave account to pay for the 2nd tier miscellaneous fees and enrichment programmes to reduce your out-of-pocket expenses.

# ONLINE CONSENT FOR IMMUNISATION SERVICES

- Immunisation Requirement on page 2 of the report:

## Immunisation Requirement

Vaccinations against conditions such as poliomyelitis are recommended under the Singapore's National Childhood Immunisation Schedule (NCIS). Vaccinations against measles and diphtheria are compulsory for all children in Singapore under the Infectious Diseases Act (in addition to being part of the NCIS).

A child in Primary 1 who is found to have incomplete dose(s) of either measles, diphtheria or poliomyelitis vaccinations will be vaccinated with any one or more of the following vaccinations by the Health Promotion Board's School Health Services (SHS), unless his/her parent or legal guardian opts out:

1. Tdap for diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis;
2. MMR for measles, mumps and rubella; and
3. IPV for poliomyelitis.

**You are deemed to have consented to have your child vaccinated by the SHS based on the NCIS if you take no further action.**

**If you DO NOT WISH your child to be vaccinated with the abovementioned vaccinations by the SHS, and wish to make your own arrangements to have your child vaccinated, please log-in at <https://childconsent.hpb.gov.sg> to indicate so.**

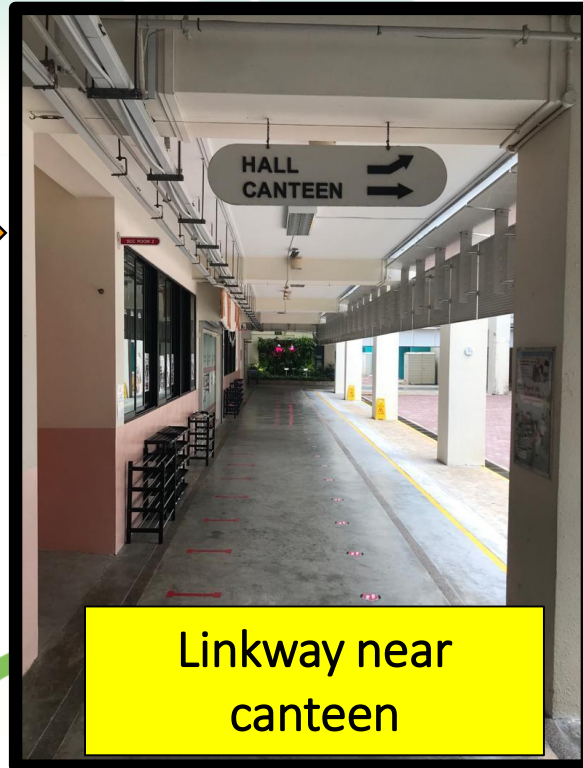
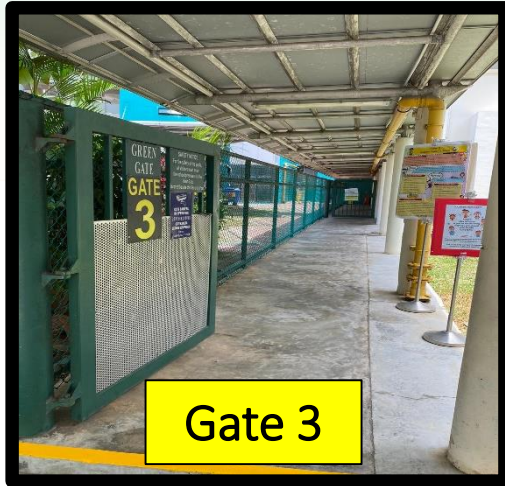


# ARRIVAL ROUTE

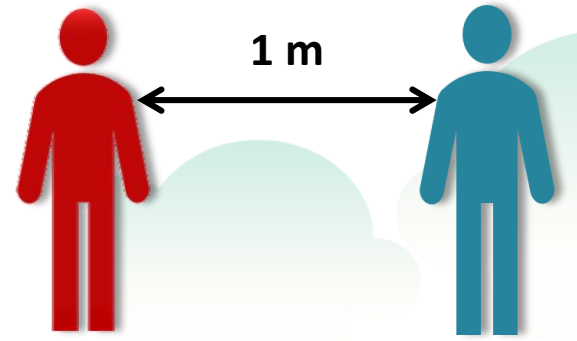
